

How to install your pulley-friction saver from the ground

1. Throw a throw line over the limb that you want to be your tie-in point.
2. Put one end of your climbing line through the pulley.
3. Attach both ends of the climbing line to one end of your throw line.
4. Put the other end of the throw line through the ring of the friction saver and pull your climbing line over the branch/limb.
5. *If the tree is small enough (or your climbing line long enough), attach the little harp on the end of your friction saver to the working end of your climbing line right below the ring of the friction saver. This way you don't have to climb all the way up to your tie-in point if you don't have to.
6. Pull the whole contraption (climbing line and pulley) through the ring and...
